This curriculum is authorised by Holroyd New Life Church and the Baptist Union of NSW. The number of lessons per grade and the length of lessons may vary between schools. Where SRE lessons are greater than 60 minutes, teachers may wish to combine lessons. In all schools, the core units should be covered first, after which SRE teachers can choose which supplementary units or lessons (from within the relevant stage) to teach from.
